Pursuant to Governor Baker's March 12, 2020, Order Suspending Certain Provisions of the Open Meeting Law, G.L. c. 30A, §18, and the Governor's March 15, 2020, Order imposing strict limitation on the number of people that may gather in one place, this meeting of the Town of Middleborough, Middleborough Gas & Electric Department Board of Commissioners will be conducted via remote participation to the greatest extent possible. In the event that we are unable to do so despite best efforts, we will post to the Town of Middleborough website an audio or video recording, transcript, or other comprehensive records of proceedings as soon as possible after the meeting.

Pursuant to MGL Chapter 30A, § 18-25,

a public body shall post notice of every meeting at least 48 hours prior to the meeting, excluding Saturdays, Sundays and legal holidays. Notice shall be printed in a legible, easily understandable format and shall contain the date, time and place of the meeting and a listing of topics that the chair reasonably anticipates will be discussed at the meeting.
