

**Middleboro Board of Selectmen  
Meeting Minutes**

**June 12, 2020**

Chairman Stewart opened the meeting at 10:01 AM.

In attendance were: Selectmen A. Battistini (remote), L. Dalpe (remote), A. Frawley (remote), N. Rosenthal and D. Stewart (remote). Also present was Town Manager, R. Nunes (remote) and Executive Assistant, Colleen Lieb.

“Pursuant to Governor Baker’s March 12, 2020 Order Suspending Certain Provisions of the Open Meeting Law, G.L. c. 30A, §18, and the Governor’s March 15, 2020 Order concerning imposition on strict limitations on the number of people that may gather in one place, and the recommendations from the CDC that no more than 10 people gather at one time, meetings in the Town of Middleborough are being conducted via remote participation to the greatest extent possible. No in person attendance of members of the public will be permitted, but every effort will be made to ensure the public can adequately access the proceedings as provided for in the Order.”

This meeting was recorded by MCCAM for broadcast on Comcast and Verizon. Board Members and Town Employee attendees were heard from through Zoom.

**DISCUSS/VOTE REQUESTS**

From Section 12 License Holders for Amendment to Existing Liquor License to Serve Alcohol in designated outdoor dining spaces with an expiration of 11/1/2020

Chairman Stewart reads the temporary application from The Hideaway located at 9 Station Street. The area for consideration will be a 20’ x 40’ tent and a 12’ x 20’ open area adjacent to the tent area for umbrella tables, to be setup in the existing parking lot. The area will be roped off and staffed at all times. The Board has no questions.

Upon motion made by Selectmen Frawley and seconded by Selectmen Dalpe, the Board voted to approve the Temporary Application for Amendment to the existing liquor license to serve alcohol in designated outdoor dining space for The Hideaway, located at 9 Station Street, as indicated.

Chairman Stewart reads the temporary application from Harry’s Bar & Grille located at 407 West Grove Street. Harry’s currently has a liquor license for outside seating capacity of 60. The submission is for an add-on deck space of 26’ x 22’ which will be surrounded by large cement blocks. The Board has no questions.

Upon motion made by Selectmen Dalpe and seconded by Selectmen Frawley, the Board voted to approve the Temporary Application for Amendment to the existing liquor license to serve alcohol in designated outdoor dining space for Harry’s Bar & Grille, located at 407 West Grove Street.

Chairman Stewart reads the temporary application from The Cabin located at 114 East Grove Street. The area is contiguous with the building & directly accessed through a door in the dining room. It is “L” shaped with some tables along the front of the building (approx. 9’ x 30’) and the rest along the side of the building (approx. 15’ x 40’). The entire area is enclosed by multiple stanchions connected by chain. The Board has no questions.

Upon motion made by Selectmen Dalpe and seconded by Selectmen Frawley, the Board voted to approve the Temporary Application for Amendment to the existing liquor license to serve alcohol in designated outdoor dining space for The Cabin, located at 114 East Grove Street.


Chairman Stewart reads the temporary application from The Boston Tavern located at 58 East Grove Street. The Boston Tavern currently has a liquor license for outdoor seating so that will be utilized along with a 30' x 40' paved area of the parking lot.

Upon motion made by Selectmen Dalpe and seconded by Selectmen Frawley, the Board voted to approve the Temporary Application for Amendment to the existing liquor license to serve alcohol in designated outdoor dining space for The Boston Tavern, located at 58 East Grove Street.
