Agreement:

The undersigned hereby agrees to comply with the provisions contained in Regulation 19 of Title 5 of The Environmental Code providing that equipment shall be subject to the inspection and approval of the Board of Health.

- a. Mobile Tanks - Mobile tanks shall be securely mounted on trucks. They shall be watertight and provided with a leak-proof cover and tight discharge valves.
- b. Venting of Mobile Tanks - Mobile tanks shall be provided with a vent constructed in a manner that will permit the escape of gas, but not the liquid contents of the tank.
- c. Hose - Suction or pressure hose shall be in good repair.
- d. Pumps - Pumps shall be maintained in a condition that will prevent the leakage of sewage.
