Town of Middleborough Mattress and Boxspring Recycling Program

The Town of Middleborough has been awarded a grant from the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (MassDEP) to recycle mattresses that have in the past ended up in the town landfill.

Residents need to visit the DPW office located at 65 Sachem Street to pay \$15.00/mattress and boxspring; then take the mattress/boxspring along with a receipt to the town transfer station at 207 Plympton Street. The mattress/boxspring will be placed in a dry container where it will be stored prior to being sent off to be deconstructed and recycled.

Acceptable Mattresses and Boxsprings

- Traditional mattresses and boxsprings constructed of metal, textiles, wood and foam.
- Crib Mattresses and Memory Foam Mattresses

Unacceptable Mattresses and Boxsprings

- Excessively Torn, punctured, soiled or moldy items
- Twisted or crushed mattresses or broken box springs
- Wet or frozen mattresses or box springs
- Mattresses or box springs infested with bed bugs or pests
- Futons and fold-out sofa beds
- Infant sleeping pads; air or water beds; any other furniture or textiles

The acceptability of mattresses and boxsprings for recycling is at the sole discretion of the Transfer station employees. Please direct any questions on the program to on-site personnel or contact the DPW office at 508-946-2481
